






<p>login</p>	<p>Login to your account at www.bingocardcreator.com by clicking "Login" at the top.</p> <p>Enter your username and password.</p>	
<p>Step 1: Create Your Cards</p>	<p>Click "Make New Cards".</p> <p>Give your bingo cards a title. Select the size (2x2, 3x3, 4x4 or 5x5).</p> <p>For words, simply type one word in each box. For picture cards, click "Add Image". A pop up box will appear. <i>*Be sure to allow pop-ups in your browser.</i></p> <p>Click "Choose File". TIP: Scroll down. The image that you selected will now in the preview card at the bottom of the screen.

Scroll up and continue to add pictures, words, or both.

Once you have added the amount of pictures/words for the size of the card you selected (2x2, 3x3, 4x4 or 5x5), click “Next Step”, located below the preview card at the bottom of the screen.



**Step 2:

Select the number of bingo cards you will need.


Select the amount you want printed on each page (1, 2 or 4).

**No matter which option you choose, each bingo card will be different.*

Style your cards the way you would like by choosing any of the other options.

Click “Print Cards” at the bottom of the page. Depending on how many cards you are printing, it may take a moment for them to generate.

Tip: You will be able to return to this step after you print your cards in the next step if you decide there is something you would like to change.




Step 3: Print

Tap “Click Here” to download your cards. They will appear as a downloaded PDF in the bottom left corner of your screen.

** You will need Adobe Acrobat reader to print your cards. Most computers have this already installed but if not, it is a free download by visiting get.adobe.com/reader.*

Tip: After you print, take a look at your cards. Choose the option to go back to Step 2 if there is something you would like to change.



FYI: The cards you just created will be saved and available for you to restyle and print anytime you log back into your account.
